# Collecting dead marine mammal parts while beachcombing

### You Need to Know

- Your ethnicity
- Land ownership it's your responsibility to know any removal restrictions.
- Population status, under ESA\*, of the marine mammal you find.

### **NON-NATIVE**

- Can collect and possess bones, teeth, and ivory ONLY
- Can NOT collect ANY part of a seal, sea lion, or whale with an ESA\* status except bearded seal (see chart below and/or page 2)
- MUST register teeth, bones, or ivory from seals, sea lions, and whales with the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS)
- MUST register teeth, bones, or ivory from walruses, polar bears, and sea otters with the US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS)

### **ALASKA NATIVE**

- For subsistence purposes -
- Can collect and possess all parts
- **MUST** register specific parts from walruses, polar bears, and sea otters with USFWS
