GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
2. March 1965

The general meeting of FNA was called to order by President Perdue at 8 pm on March 2nd 1965. There were 25 members present.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The treasurers report was missing; however, Maurice Thompson gave the present bank balance.

There was a discussion on the forthcoming Chiefs Conference. Ralph gave a list of confirmations he had rec'd from the villages.

It was suggested that we try to get Jimmy Huntington to give the Closing speech at the Conference. Ralph agreed to approach Don Ouden at Station KEAR to see if they would be interested in bringing him into broadcast the dog races, as they have done in previous years.

After some discussion Maurice Thompson moved we limit our potlatch purchases of food to \$300.00. The motion was seconded by Richard Frank. Motion carried.

Maurice reported that the Fairbanks Dog Musers Ass'n would pay 50% of the cost of having signs made up for advertising the sponsors of the Men and Women's North American Championship races. We would put these on display at the Potlatch than the Dog Musher's Ass'n would use them at the Musher's banquet.

The guest speaker was Mrs. Redman. She spoke on Anti-Poverty Program. She extended an invitation to someone from our group to join the Steering Committee which was being formed. The meeting to be held at 8 pm March 11.

Ralph appointed Beverly Huhndorf, Poldine Carlo, Mollie Galbreath, Maurice Thompson, and Jules Wright to the Committee.

Ralph reported that Mrs. Martin had contacted him in regards to hiring a disabled person or any interested person who would like a job doing embroidery work by machine. She has just received a new machine and any person applying would receive on-the-job training w/a salary of from \$3,000 - \$4,000 yr.

Ralph showed us a sample of a lottery ticket he would like to have passed thru the legislature authorizing the Ass'n to use as a means of raising money to build a "Dog Musers Hall of Fame". This was tabled till a later meeting.

Mollie Galbreath moved that if we have any excess money that we deposit it at First Federal Savings where it would earn 4 1/2%. This was tabled.

The next meeting was set for the 16th of March when final arrangements would be made for the Potlatch.

Sharon Olin moved the meeting be adjourned. Motion was seconded and carried. Meeting adjourned at 10:pm.
